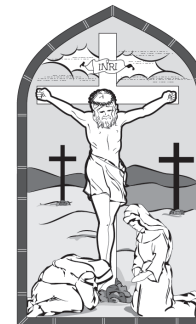
STATIONS OF THE CROSS

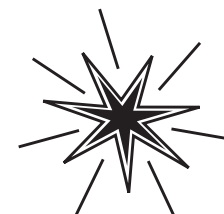
Christmas Mass
