WAKE SERVICES

At the wake of every member of our Council, a prayer service is held. The group is lead by our Deputy Grand Knight, our Chaplain and other members who may or may not have personally known the deceased member. The Senior Knights have been very supportive of this Council function. The service day and time is noted in the newspaper obituary. When a well-known member dies, there is a large turnout for the wake service. Often, when an older member dies, who may not have a large family, we are a major part of the wake. And we are very much appreciated by the family. The service is held, usually, at 7:30 on the last night of the wake. So we ask all members – check the daily obituaries and if you see that a member has died, show up for 15 minutes and offer a prayer for the repose of his soul – wouldn't you like someone to show up for your wake? (Please, if you are at the wake as a friend or family member when the Knights show up to pray, walk up and join the group and be proud to stand as a member of the Knights of Columbus.)

Bishop Robert J. Cunningham was present on Sunday, September 26 to celebrate Mass for the 100th anniversary of St. Mary's. Before Mass, the Bishop, along with Father Valentine Krul, 20 other area priests, and a large contingent of 4th Degree Color Corps, processed from the school to the new outside Stations of the Cross for prayers and a formal blessing of the Stations. 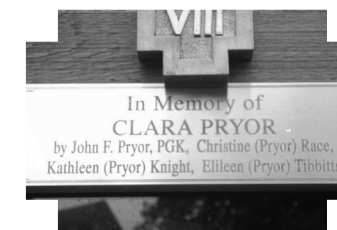
