On September 11, 2001, America lived through a heartwrenching event. The Knights of Columbus was among the first organizations to respond, establishing the "Heroes Fund" only a day later to offer immediate financial assistance to the devastated families of fallen police, firefighters, and emergency personnel, regardless of their religious affiliation. The Supreme Council donated \$500,000 to the fund, which was soon matched by local councils worldwide. Ultimately, the fund drive collected more than \$1.49 million in contributions.

K of C Disaster Response Program

The program, initially led by by 9/11 first responder and survivor Capt. Alfredo Fuentes, a New York City fire fighter, coordinates K of C support to victims of natural and manmade disasters. Plans are made in advance, and special emphasis is placed on involving Knights who are either current or retired first responders.
