RESERVATIONS.....VERY IMPORTANT!!!



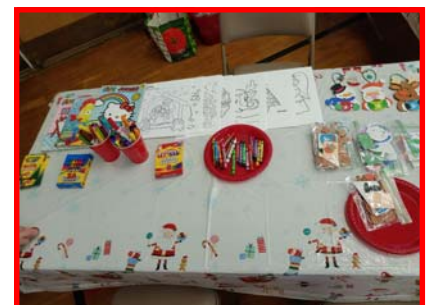

Veteran's Outreach Center (Located 726 Washington St., Utica, NY 13502 315 765-0975) Founded locally in 1973 by returning Vietnam Veterans, today's Veterans Outreach Center remains anchored in our community and offers a comprehensive portfolio of supportive services designed to meet the needs of veterans and their families. Through the generosity of our community, all of these programs and services are provided free of charge.

Mother Marianne's West Side Kitchen & West Side Boutique (Located at St. Joseph St. Patrick Church campus. 702 Columbia St., Utica NY 13502 315-735-3289) Mother Marianne's West Side Kitchen provides hot meals and/or bag lunches every day (11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.) to struggling families and individuals, the unemployed, and the homeless. The soup kitchen partners with other agencies to provide informational and educational programs, as well as referrals, for those in need. Founded in 2008, the operation is sustained through volunteers and donations. The soup kitchen is named after Utica, NY's first and only saint – Mother Marianne Cope, who grew up in the parish before becoming a Franciscan sister and spending the last 30 years of her life caring for leprosy patients in Hawaii.
