KNIGHTS IN THE NEWS

Hon. Anthony J. Garramone (1966) Inducted into the Oneida County Historical Hall of Fame Class of 2023. Judge Garramone was a respected judge with a long and distinguished career in public service. A graduate of Thomas R. Proctor High School and Utica College, he served in the US Navy and earned a Juris Doctorate from Syracuse University College of Law. Before his judicial career, he served two terms on the Utica Common Council, as counsel to the City of Utica Board of Education, and on the City of Utica Water Board. He was elected to the first of three terms as City of Utica Judge in 1981 and was elevated to Chief Judge in 1994. He retired with esteem in 2003. Judge Garramone is a past presiding member of the Judicial Section of the NYS Bar Association and past president of the NYS Association of City Court Judges. He taught at Utica College from 1965-2007 and served on the boards of many community organizations including the Utica Children's Museum, Community Arts Council, Munson Williams Proctor Arts Institute, Mohawk Valley Community College, and the Mohawk Valley Community College Foundation. Today he serves as the City of Utica Common Council's attorney.
